

STRATEGIC PLAN

The OFMA Board proposes for your consideration 8. a 2001 Strategic Plan - Goals and Objectives to accomplish in the 2000/2001 year. Additional goals are solicited from 9. members.

- 1. Educate OFMA members, floodplain administrators, and the public on *National Flood Programs in Review 2000*
- 2. Foster local and individual responsibility and capability for flood problems.
- Provide training and education for professionals and the public.
- 4. Contact all 358 Oklahoma Local Floodplain Administrators to identify issues and problems.
- 5. Encourage all local floodplain administrators to attend training, join OFMA, and see certification (CFM).
- 6. Promote Mandatory Basic Floodplain Management 101 training for all Floodplain Administrators.
- 7. Seek grants/funding to expand OFMA's outreach to educate public about floodplain management, especially schools.

- 8. Pursue funding for House Bill 1841 (Flood Hazard Mitigation).
- 9. Explore a Joint Annual Conference with Oklahoma Emergency Managers for 2001.
- Insure Floodplain Managers are listed in the Oklahoma Municipal League's Directory.
- 11. Begin work on statewide inventory of floodplain buildings by jurisdiction.
- 12. Seek State funding for OWRB's CAP Program position, use federal funds while available for additional program assistance.
- Amend Oklahoma Floodplain Management Act to allow NFIP communities to set permit fees for floodplain development permits.
- 14. Produce a brochure/flyer about OFMA's professional floodplain managers certification program (CFM)
- Work with ODCEM, OWRB, FEMA to develop community repetitive loss plans to reduce number of RL Properties in Oklahoma.

National Accreditation for Oklahoma CERTIFIED FLOODPLAIN MANAGERS

OFMA Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM) who were certified prior to September 1999, are certified in Oklahoma only.

In July 1999, OFMA revised it's CFM exams

to meet ASFPM's National Exam Standards. The first OFMA Nationally Accredited Exams were given at OFMA's 1999 Fall Conference at Lake Murray. Additional exams were given in Norman at OWRB's week long NFIP class in January



2000, and OFMA's Spring 2000 Technical Training at the Moore/Norman Technology Center.

To be a nationally accredited CFM, you must have taken the new, nationally accredited CFM exam. CFM's who are already nationally accredited (tested

since 1999) **DO NOT** have to retake the exam.

OFMA will offer the new nationally accredited CFM exam **FREE** to all original (before September 1999) CFM's at the Fall 2000 conference and other

training opportunities later this year (January's OWRB NFIP and OFMA's Spring Training).

Oklahoma CFM's will receive a packet in the mail. Oklahoma CFM's wishing to take the new, nationally accredited CFM exam at the Fall Conference should fill out the form and return

it to OFMA as soon as possible.

Those Oklahoma CFM's not interested in national accreditation may retain their Oklahoma CFM designation.


