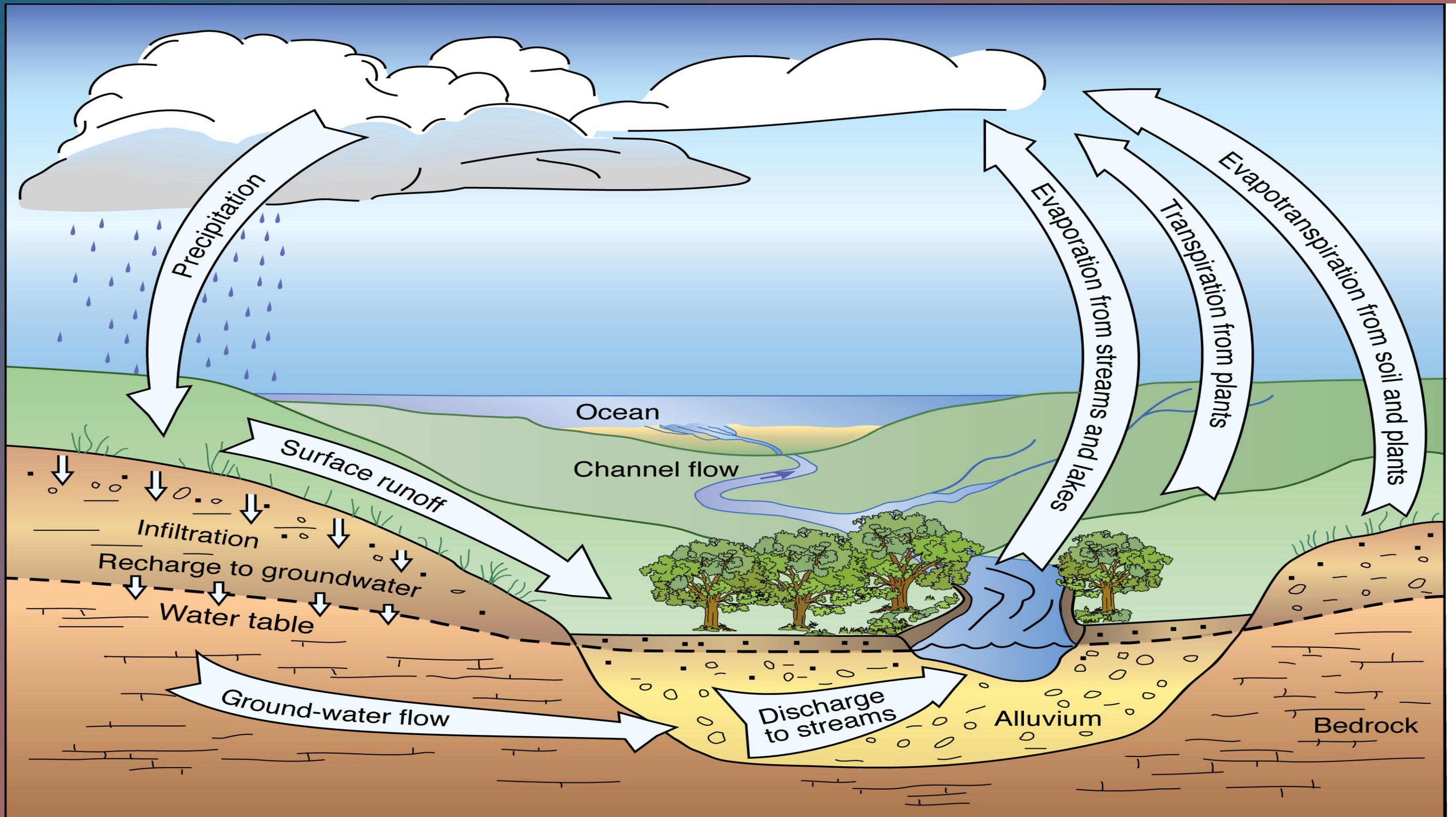
OFMA Board Action – October 27, 2023

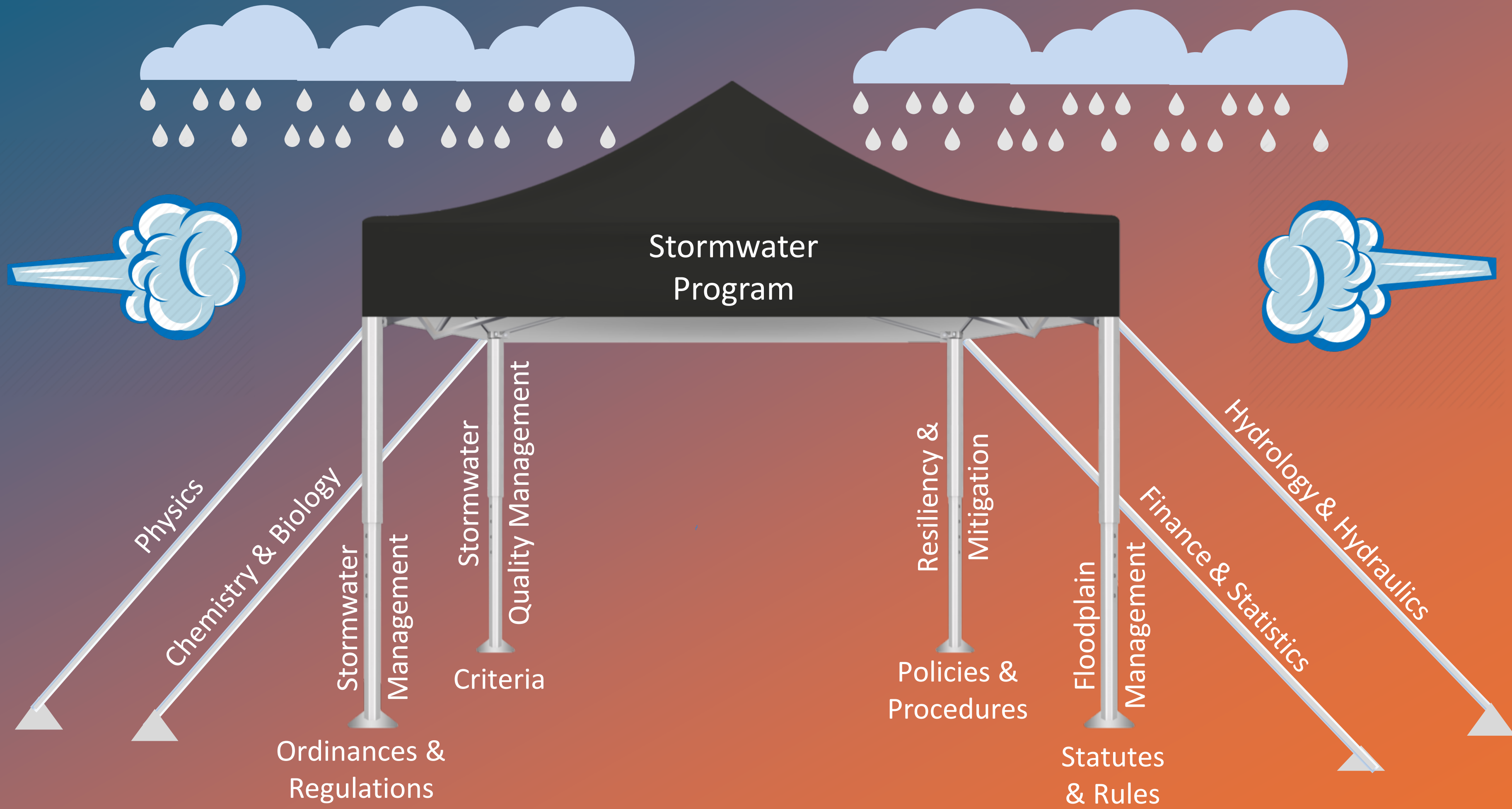
OFMA Board Action – October 27, 2023

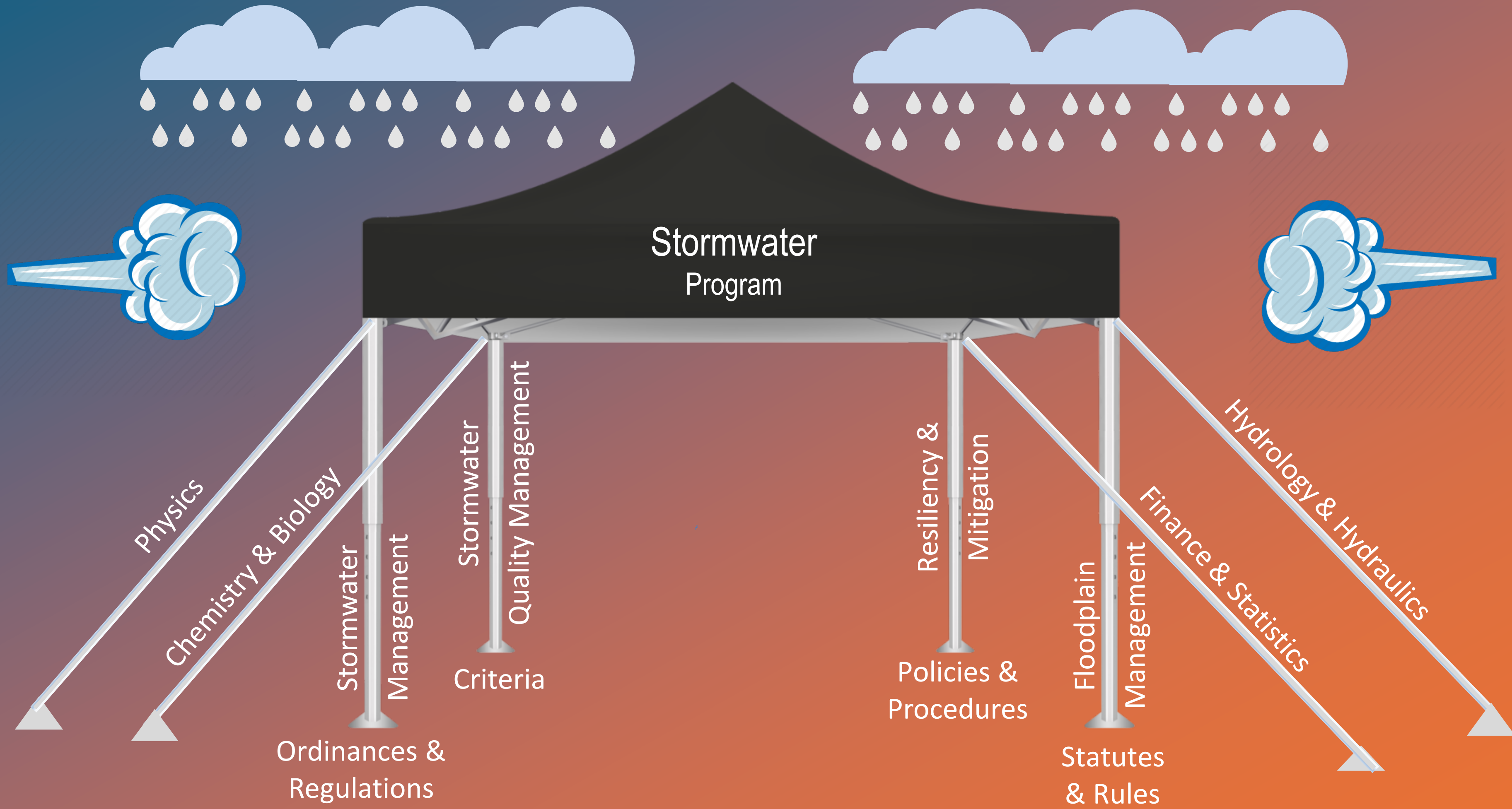
